Art Market Hamptons' 12th Edition, the First at Nova's Ark Project and Sculpture Park, Closes With Strong Sales

Bridgehampton, New York - [Art Market Hamptons](#), the East End's premier and longest-running art fair, saw strong sales and notable attendance of near 10,000 enthusiastic collectors and art lovers across the 4-day event, which took place from **August 11th to 14th** for the first time on **Nova's Ark Project and Sculpture Park's** unique, sprawling grounds.

The fair's 12th edition featured around ninety top galleries presenting the best in modern and contemporary art and design from around the world in the new museum-quality pavilion set in the 94 acre preserve, which is home to the towering, abstract sculptures created by the park's founder and namesake, artist Nova Mihai Popa.

Highlights from this year's event included a strong list of local stalwart galleries that have defined the region for the last few decades, set-up alongside impressive collections from national and international modern and contemporary dealers. Galleries reported productive engagement with both new and existing clientele and strong sales at a wide range of price points from an audience of invigorated collectors.

Visitors were treated to a number of innovative installations, including ***Worth & Weight***, a large-scale, archaeological-minded piece by **Morgan Hobbs** that depicts a site of ruins made almost entirely from recycled materials, presented by **VSOP Projects**; **Norman Mooney's** exploration into elemental and cyclical synergies of nature with his bold sculpture ***Bloom***, presented by **C Fine Art**; **Mary Mattingly's** abstract, graffiti-inspired metal work, ***On a roll***, presented by **Alessandro Berni Gallery**; and ***Sans Titre Ref (334)*** by **Nicolas Dubreuille**, a sculpture showcasing the joined forces of color and geometry presented by **Galerie Duret**. Additionally, **amArtHouse** presented a couple of stunning sculptures: **Richard Pitt's** bright red, coated aluminum sculpture, ***Barking at the Moon***, and **Ed Smith's *Victory Striding***, constructed out of patinated bronze, as did **AiBo Gallery** with **Moises Morgenstern's** optical, welded structural installations: ***Dancing Lovers*** and ***Spinning Antler***.

This year, Art Market Hamptons also partnered with numerous institutions from around New York including **Africa NXT**, **American Folk Art Museum**, **ArtTable**, **Association of Women Art Dealers**,

Brooklyn Museum, Bronx Museum, Children's Museum of the East End, Japan Society, Neue Galerie, POWarts, The Jewish Museum, and many more.
